What is Texas HCN?

In 2005, the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) introduced the Texas HCN with a purpose of helping employers better control the rising cost of claims. This legislation focused on certifying networks of healthcare providers dedicated to facilitating the return-to-work process, adhering to treatment guidelines, and providing timely care to injured workers.

Who is Prime Health Services?

Prime Health Services is the certified workers' compensation network contracted with our family of insurance companies, Benchmark and American Liberty. If you choose to enroll in the network, Prime Health Services will manage your employees' healthcare in the event of a work-related injury. Certified in 250 of the 254 counties in Texas, Prime Health Services proudly provides access to over 21,000 healthcare providers statewide.

Do employers need to enroll in the HCN?

Enrollment is required to participate in the HCN. Any employer located within Prime's service area may enroll in the Texas HCN. Upon enrollment, employers gain access to network discounts and guidance for care within the HCN, connecting you with quality medical providers. These are some of the benefits employers will experience when enrolled in the HCH:

- ✓ Prompt access to quality medical care can enhance workforce productivity by prioritizing customized injury treatment plans, resulting in a quick return to work for the injured employees.
- ✓ Enhanced communication with treating providers for improved collaboration among all parties.

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HCN process and employer responsibilities

As an employer enrolling in the Prime Texas HCN, you are **required** to fulfill the following responsibilities and communicate the network requirements to your employees through the steps outlined below.

- ✓ Distribute information packets on how to receive healthcare services through compensation insurance.
- Display information at each business location.
- ✓ Provide packets to new hires within three days.
- ✓ Obtain signed acknowledgments from employees.
- Establish a standard process for packet delivery or use an acknowledgment form log.
